Dear Congressman Gosar,

On behalf of the American Supply Association (ASA), the national trade association serving wholesale distributors and manufacturers in the plumbing, heating, cooling, piping (PHCP) and industrial and mechanical pipe, valves, and fittings (PVF) industry, **I thank you for your leadership in introducing H.R. 687**, the *Southeast Land Exchange and Conservation Act*. ASA appreciates your efforts to address and expand our country's copper supply and improve access to America's untapped resources.

The PHCP and PVF channel encompasses nearly 3,600 corporations with 5,000 outlets and 75,000 employees nationwide. As a key channel partner in the homebuilding, remodeling and commercial construction industry, ASA's member companies are frequent users of copper for the fabrication of valves, pipes and other plumbing products.
