Roger Cliff is a Senior Fellow at the Atlantic Council where he does research on East Asian security issues. Previously he has worked for the Center for Strategic and Budgetary Assessments, the Project 2049 Institute, the RAND Corporation, the Office of the Secretary of Defense, and VERAC, Inc. He has authored, co-authored, or edited more than 30 books, articles, book chapters, and op-eds on topics including China's military doctrine and training, China's defense industries, and U.S. strategy and policy in the Asia-Pacific.
