15	ments Act of 2008 (Public Law 110-261; 15 50 U.S.C.
16	1801 note) through the date of the enactment of this Act.
17	(b) Website Publication Required.—Not later
18	than 30 days after the date of the enactment of this Act,

- 4 and the Office of the Director of National Intelligence, re-

- 6 (c) Definitions.—In this section, the terms "United
- 7 States person" and "electronic surveillance" have the
- 8 meaning given such terms in section 101 of the Foreign
- 9 Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978 (50 U.S.C. 1801).
