

**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT
FOR H.R. 4681
OFFERED BY MR. GRAYSON OF FLORIDA**

At the end of subtitle B of title III, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. ____.** **DISCLOSURE OF THE NUMBER OF UNITED**
2 **STATES PERSONS WHOSE INFORMATION HAS**
3 **BEEN COLLECTED, ACQUIRED, OR RETAINED**
4 **UNDER THE FOREIGN INTELLIGENCE SUR-**
5 **VEILLANCE ACT OF 1978.**

6 (a) **DISCLOSURE REQUIRED.**—Not later than 30 days
7 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Attorney
8 General, in consultation with the Director of National In-
9 telligence, shall submit to all Members of Congress a re-
10 port on the number of United States persons whose infor-
11 mation has been acquired through electronic surveillance
12 authorized in accordance with title I of the Foreign Intel-
13 ligence Surveillance Act of 1978 (50 13 U.S.C. 1801 et
14 seq.) from the date of the enactment of the FISA Amend-
15 ments Act of 2008 (Public Law 110-261; 15 50 U.S.C.
16 1801 note) through the date of the enactment of this Act.

17 (b) **WEBSITE PUBLICATION REQUIRED.**—Not later
18 than 30 days after the date of the enactment of this Act,

1 the Attorney General and the Director of National Intel-
2 ligence shall publish the information described in sub-
3 section (a) on the website of the Department of Justice
4 and the Office of the Director of National Intelligence, re-
5 spectively.

6 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section, the terms “United
7 States person” and “electronic surveillance” have the
8 meaning given such terms in section 101 of the Foreign
9 Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978 (50 U.S.C. 1801).
