

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4435
OFFERED BY MR. BARBER OF ARIZONA

At the end of title VI, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 6___ . REPORT ON ELIGIBILITY OF MEMBERS OF THE**
2 **ARMED FORCES FOR SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRI-**
3 **TION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM AND USE OF**
4 **SUPPLEMENTAL SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCE.**

5 Not later than March 1, 2015, the Secretary of De-
6 fense and the Secretary of the Department in which Coast
7 Guard is operating shall submit to the congressional de-
8 fense committees a report providing information for fiscal
9 years 2013 and 2014 on the eligibility of members of the
10 Armed Forces for the supplemental nutrition assistance
11 program and their receipt of the supplemental subsistence
12 allowance. The report shall include, for each individual
13 branch of the Armed Services and Coast Guard, the fol-
14 lowing:

15 (1) The number of members who, solely based
16 on their gross monthly pay reported on their leave
17 and earnings statement, had household income below
18 the level specified in section 2014(c)(2) of the Food
19 and Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2014).

1 (2) The number of members who, solely based
2 on their gross monthly pay minus combat pay as de-
3 fined under section 2014(d)(19) of the Food and
4 Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2014), had house-
5 hold income below the level specified in section
6 2014(c)(2) of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008
7 (7 U.S.C. 2014).

8 (3) The number of members who, solely based
9 on their gross monthly pay, minus combat pay as
10 defined under section 2014(d)(19) of the Food and
11 Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2014) and pay-
12 ments for the basic allowance for housing under sec-
13 tion 403 of title 37, United States Code, had house-
14 hold income below the level specified in section
15 2014(c)(2) of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008
16 (7 U.S.C. 2014).

17 (4) The number of members who were provided
18 the supplemental subsistence allowance under sec-
19 tion 402a of title 37, United States Code.

20 (5) The number of members who were not eligi-
21 ble for the supplemental subsistence allowance dur-
22 ing fiscal years 2013 and 2014, but who would have
23 been eligible for the allowance if the Secretary con-
24 cerned did not take into consideration the basic al-

- 2 United States Code.
