3 (2) A list of parts of the supply chain, including  
4 direct and indirect suppliers, where there is inad-  
5 adequate information to ascertain whether the produc-

7 ficking in persons, or the worst forms of child labor.

8 (3) The recommendations of the Comptroller  
9 General on which direct or indirect suppliers do not  
10 combat forced labor, slavery, trafficking in persons,  
11 or the worst forms of child labor as well as rec-  
12 ommendations on how to ensure that direct and in-  
13 direct suppliers combat forced labor, slavery, traf-  
14 ficking in persons, or the worst forms of child labor.

15 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

16 (1) The term “appropriate congressional com-  
17 mittees” means—

18 (A) the Committees on Armed Services of  
19 the Senate and the House of Representatives;  
20 and

21 (B) the Committee on Homeland Security  
22 and Governmental Affairs of the Senate and the  
23 Committee on Oversight and Government Re-  
24 form of the House of Representatives.

1           (2) The terms “forced labor”, “slavery”, and  
2           “human trafficking” mean any labor practice or  
3           human trafficking activity in violation of national  
4           and international standards, including International  
5           Labor Organization Convention No. 182, the Traf-  
6           ficking Victims Protection Act of 2000 (Public Law  
7           106–386), and acts that would violate the criminal  
8           provisions related to slavery and human trafficking  
9           under chapter 77 of title 18, United States Code, if  
10          they had been committed within the jurisdiction of  
11          the United States.

12          (3) The term “the worst forms of child labor”  
13          means child labor in violation of national and inter-  
14          national standards, including International Labor  
15          Organization Convention No. 182.
