A BILL

To reauthorize the Debbie Smith DNA Backlog Grant Program.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Debbie Smith Reau-
- 5 thorization Act of 2008".
- 6 SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE DEBBIE SMITH DNA
- 7 BACKLOG GRANT PROGRAM.
- 8 Section 2 of the DNA Analysis Backlog Elimination
- 9 Act of 2000 (42 U.S.C. 14135) is amended—
- 10 (1) in subsection (c)(3)—

1	(A) by striking subparagraphs (A) through
2	(D);
3	(B) by redesignating subparagraph (E) as
4	subparagraph (A); and
5	(C) by inserting after subparagraph (A)
6	(as so redesignated) the following new subpara-
7	graph:
8	"(B) For each of the fiscal years 2010
9	through 2014, not less than 40 percent of the
10	grant amounts shall be awarded for purposes
11	under subsection (a)(2) of this section."; and
12	(2) by amending subsection (j) to read as fol-
13	lows:
14	"(j) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
15	are authorized to be appropriated to the Attorney General
16	for grants under subsection (a) of this section
17	\$151,000,000 for each of the fiscal years 2009 through
18	2014.".
