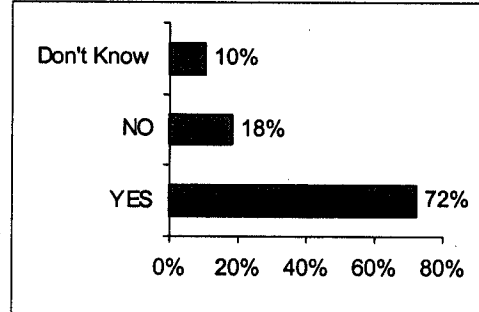

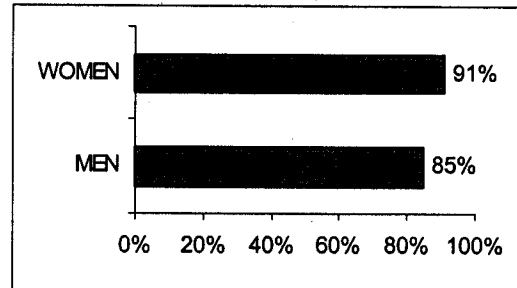
7 out of 10 people surveyed think that the Constitution **ALREADY** makes it clear that male and female citizens are entitled to *equal rights*.\*
