Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States relative to equal rights for men and women.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled
- 3 (two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-
- 4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-
- 5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all
- 6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when
- 7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several
- 8 States:

1	"ARTICLE—
2	"Section 1. Equality of rights under the law shall
3	not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any
4	State on account of sex.
5	"Section 2. The Congress shall have the power to
6	enforce, by appropriate legislation, the provisions of this
7	article.

- 8 "Section 3. This amendment shall take effect two
- 9 years after the date of ratification.".
