RESOLUTION

Marking the 60th anniversary of the United States Supreme Court decision *Brown* v. *Board of Education*.

- Whereas May 17, 2014, marks the 60th anniversary of the United States Supreme Court decision, *Brown v. Board* of Education, 347 U.S. 483 (1954);
- Whereas Brown v. Board of Education overturned Plessy v. Ferguson, 163 U.S. 537 (1896);
- Whereas in *Brown* v. *Board of Education*, the Supreme Court held that "Separate educational facilities are inherently unequal," and that segregation of schools violates the equal protection clause of the 14th Amendment; and

- Whereas *Brown* v. *Board of Education* was a major milestone in the 20th century civil rights movement: Now, therefore, be it
 - Resolved, That the House of Representatives marks
 the 60th anniversary of Brown v. Board of Education, 347
 U.S. 483 (1954), which signaled the end of state-sanc tioned segregation of schools in the United States, so that
 it is unlawful to deny access to public facilities on the basis
 of race.
