

## Amendments to H.R. 2822—Fiscal Year 2016 Interior and Environment Appropriations (Calvert, R-CA) – Part I

## **AMENDMENTS WITH REQUESTED VOTES:**

- 1. <u>Garamendi (D-CA)</u>: Would increase funding for the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service by \$3.902 million and reduce Bureau of Land Management, Management of Lands and Resources by \$4.01 million.
- 2. <u>Capps (D-CA)</u>: Would increase funding for EPA Inland Oil Spill Programs by \$5.434 million and would reduce Bureau of Ocean Energy Management by the same amount.
- 3. <u>Sablan (D-MP)</u>: Would increase Insular Affairs, Assistant to the Territories by \$5 million and would reduce Department of the Interior Departmental Operations by the same amount.

The Office of insular Affairs provides financial assistance to the governments of the U.S. territories. The bill would provide \$85.976 million for this account, equal to the enacted FY 2015 level.

4. <u>Castor (D-FL)</u>: Would increase EPA Environmental Programs and Management by \$1.913 million and would reduce Department of the Interior Departmental Operations by the same amount.
