<u>CONGRESSMAN KEVIN BRADY</u> <u>RECEIVES LIFETIME TAX FIGHTER AWARD</u>

The National Tax Limitation Committee (NTLC) has honored House Ways and Means Committee Chairman Kevin Brady with a "Lifetime Tax Fighter Award." NTLC President Lewis K. Uhler presented the award to Congressman Brady today in the Chairman's office in Washington, saying "Congressman Brady's votes on tax and spending issues throughout his years in Congress earned him consistent 'A' grades and now the Lifetime Tax Fighter Award.

"Congressman Brady has led the battle on behalf of taxpayers to reduce tax rates and the complexity of the tax code, to provide incentives for private savings, investment and job creation and to control the growth of federal spending.
