## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Inspector General Va-

5 cancy Act of 2014".

- 9 lowing new subsection:

1 "(h) NOMINATION OF INSPECTOR GENERAL TO FILL 2 A VACANCY.—If the President does not nominate an In-3 spector General pursuant to subsection (a) within 180 4 days after a vacancy for the Inspector General, the indi-5 vidual serving as interim Inspector General shall be 6 deemed to be appointed under such subsection, by and 7 with the advice and consent of the Senate.".
