The amendment in the na-6 ture of a substitute recommended by the Committee on 7 Ways and Means now printed in the bill shall be consid-8 ered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered 9 as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question shall be 10 11 considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any 12 further amendment thereto, to final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally di-13 14 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority 15 member of the Committee on Ways and Means; and (2) one motion to recommit with or without instructions. 16
