On behalf of Iraq and Afghanistan Veterans of America (IAVA) and its 400,000 members, we are pleased to offer our support for the 21st Century Veterans Benefits Act.

While the VA deserves some credit in working to reduce the disability claims backlog by 36.5% from a high of 611,000 in March 2013, more needs to be done to continue to make sure veterans are receiving consistent, timely, and accurate claims decisions.

This legislation would modernize and improve the disability claims process for veterans. Too often, a veteran has to wait an extended period of time before a final decision is rendered in regard to his or her application for disability-compensation. The VA must improve internal processes and leverage the proven accuracy and production benchmarks of high performing regional offices in order to assist regional offices that under perform. The interagency data sharing standards with regard to the timely collection of veteran health records, is one of many legislative provisions in this bill that will ensure the VA shortens its timeline on delivering results for veterans.
