4 Section 2012(a) of title 38, United States Code, is
5 amended by adding at the end the following new para6 graph:

7 "(4) Services for which a recipient of a grant under 8 section 2011 of this title (or an entity described in para-9 graph (1)) may receive per diem payments under this sub-10 section may include furnishing care for a dependent of a 11 homeless veteran who is under the care of such homeless 12 veteran while such homeless veteran receives services from 13 the grant recipient (or entity).".
