Note: The following information is generic in nature. For more specific information, you are advised to visit each academy's website as well as the catalogs for each academy.

The U.S. Service Academies are among the most highly respected, quality educational programs in the nation. To be admitted to an academy, you must meet stringent academic, physical, and medical requirements specified by public law. However, the academies look at the "whole person" when considering admission. Character, leadership, physical aptitude, mental fitness, and motivation are some of the key components of a favorable evaluation for admission.

The nomination process is a two-fold process. All prospective applicants must establish contact with the Admission's Office at the academy of their choice. Each member of Congress may not have more than five midshipmen or cadets at each academy at any one time. Generally speaking I will have one opening per year at each academy.

General Guidelines

- Be at least 17 years old, but have not passed their 23rd birthday (25 years for U.S. Merchant Marine)
- Be a citizen of the United States.
- Be unmarried, not pregnant or have any legal obligation to support children or dependents.
- Be a legal resident of the 11th Congressional District in Florida.

Academic Guidelines

Although the academy will be reviewing the "whole applicant", your academic performance is the most weighted. You are encouraged to take the SAT/ACT test multiple times in order to improve your score. The academies do not establish minimums; however, candidates who score below the following will not be interviewed by Congressman Nugent's Academy Review Board.

SAT- minimum combined score 1200 (SAT Testing Code Number 0369) ACT- minimum combined score 26 (ACT testing Code Number 7331)

On a separate page, provide a typed essay (250 words or 1-2 pages maximum) answering the following questions (the essay must be submitted with this application):

- 1. Why are you seeking a nomination?
- 2. Why do you feel you are qualified?
- 3. Why do you want to be commissioned?

You must also attach your two letters of recommendation and a one-page resume. Due to the fact that the academies hold to the "whole person" concept, it is important to ask individuals who have watched you develop in all aspects of your life. Some suggestions are: teachers, coaches, pastors/priests, family friends, school counselors, school administrators. Please keep in mind that we will only accept two letters of recommendation. In your resume be sure to document all of your school and community extra-curricular activities, athletics, and leadership positions. This may include, but is not limited to: band, boys/girls state, choir, church groups, drama, drill team, key club, ROTC, school newspaper, student government.

In addition, please send your sealed and official high school and college (if applicable) transcripts, SAT and/or ACT scores, and a current photograph along with your application.

Interviews

Interviews are mandatory and non-waiverable for qualifying applicants. If you are a military family living outside the state of Florida, you <u>must</u> call to discuss your interview options.

Sworn Statement

I have fully read and understand the requirements and procedures for appointment to the United States Service Academies by Congressman Rich Nugent and do hereby apply for nomination with the full intention of serving as a career officer upon graduation. I am also aware of the postmark deadline of November 1st. I certify that I am a legal resident of the 11th Congressional District and there is no reason why I should not be medically qualified to receive an appointment to a service academy if nominated.
