- i. Division B of P.L. 114-223 (Zika Response and Preparedness Act, 2017) provided \$1,108 million in budget authority in fiscal year 2016; the President requested \$1,797 million. Division C (Continuing Appropriations Act, 2017) provided \$500 million in fiscal year 2016 for disaster relief and Division D (Rescissions of Funds) rescinded \$400 million in previously appropriated budget authority; the President did not request additional amounts for disaster relief or propose amounts for rescission.
