AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 2609 OFFERED BY Ms. Bean and Mr. Royce

At the end of the bill, add the following new section:

1	SEC STUDY ON MODERNIZATION AND IMPROVEMENT
2	OF INSURANCE REGULATION IN THE UNITED
3	STATES.
4	(a) STUDY.—The Director of the Federal Insurance
5	Office appointed under section 313(b) of title 31, United
6	States Code (as amended by section 2(a)(3) of this Act)
7	shall conduct a study on how to modernize and improve
8	the system of insurance regulation in the United States.
9	Such study shall include consideration of the following:
10	(1) Effective systemic risk regulation with re-
11	spect to insurance.
12	(2) Strong capital standards and an appro-
13	priate match between capital allocation and liabil-
14	ities for all risk.
15	(3) Meaningful and consistent consumer protec-
16	tion for insurance products and practices.
17	(4) Increased national uniformity through ei-
18	ther a Federal charter or effective action by the
19	States.

1	(5) Improved and broadened regulation of in-
2	surance companies and affiliates on a consolidated
3	basis, including affiliates outside of the traditional
4	insurance business.
5	(6) International coordination.
6	(b) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the date
7	of the enactment of this Act, the Director shall submit
8	to the Committee on Financial Services of the House of
9	Representatives and the Committee on Banking, Housing,
0	and Urban Affairs of the Senate a report containing—
1	(1) the results of the study conducted under
2	subsection (a); and
3	(2) any legislative, administrative, or regulatory
4	recommendations that the Director considers appro-
5	priate to modernize and improve the system of in-
6	surance regulation in the United States.
7	(c) Consultation.—In carrying out subsections (a)
8	and (b), the Director shall consult with State insurance
9	commissioners, consumer organizations, representatives of
20	the insurance industry, policyholders, and other persons,
21	as the Director considers appropriate.
