# **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **1. MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS**

To apply for a nomination to the Air Force, Military and Naval Academies, you must meet the following minimum requirements:

- You must be a citizen of the United States
- You must reside in the Eighth Congressional District of Maryland
- You must not be married, pregnant, or have any dependents
- You must be at least 17 years of age but not older than 23 years of age on July 1, 2017

To apply for a nomination to the Merchant Marine Academy, you must meet the following minimum requirements:

- You must be a citizen of the United States
- You must reside in Maryland
- You must be at least 17 years of age but not older than 25 years of age on July 1, 2017
- Note: You may seek a nomination from any Member of Congress in Maryland.

#### 2. THE APPLICATION PROCESS

To be considered for a nomination to a United States Service Academy, <u>the completed application</u> <u>together with ALL supporting materials must be received in Rep. Van Hollen's Rockville office by</u> <u>5:00 p.m. on Friday, October 14, 2016.</u> Because of the extremely strong competition for nominations, you are encouraged to apply for nominations from other sources, including President Obama, Vice President Biden, Senator Cardin, and Senator Mikulski.

**Standardized Testing.** Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) and American College Testing (ACT) scores will be considered in the selection of academy nominees.

The SAT will be administered on January 23, March 5, May 7, and June 4, 2016. You should request that your SAT scores be sent directly to Rep. Van Hollen's office. The office code number is **5985**.

The ACT will be administered on February 6, April 9 and June 11, 2016. You should request that your ACT scores be sent directly to Rep. Van Hollen's office. The office code number is **7450**.

## \*\*\*The results of the fall SAT and ACT will arrive too late for consideration in your application. These test results will only be accepted after October 14, 2016 to demonstrate improvement over previous scores.\*\*\*

**Transcripts.** An official transcript from the Guidance Office of your high school must be included with your application materials. The transcript must list your senior year courses. Please also provide a transcript for any college work that you have completed.

Letters of Recommendation. Three letters of recommendation are required, <u>including one from a</u> <u>science or math teacher</u>. Other letters of recommendation may come from teachers, guidance counselors, coaches, and/or employers. Letters from family members will not be accepted. <u>No more</u> <u>than three letters will be accepted.</u>

All recommendation letters must be in sealed envelopes and included with your application materials.

**Service Academy Review Board Interviews.** Each qualified applicant will be interviewed by Rep. Van Hollen's Service Academy Advisory Board. The Service Academy Advisory Board will conduct interviews on **Saturday, November 19, 2016**. Qualified applicants who submit a completed application by October 14, 2016 will be notified <u>by mail</u> of their interview appointment date and time.

# **Your completed application:** Please send your completed application to Rep. Van Hollen's Rockville office. **An application is considered complete only if it includes ALL of the following items**:

- 1. Checklist
- 2. Basic Fact Sheet, including a 2" x 2" photo of yourself
- 3. Applicant Questionnaire
- 4. Applicant Essay Handwritten and typed
- 5. Notarized Affidavit of Residence
- 6. Three letters of recommendation (one must be from a science or math teacher)
- 7. High school/college transcripts

Your SAT and/or ACT scores should be sent directly to Rep. Van Hollen's office. The completed application must be received **no later than 5:00 p.m. on October 14, 2016** at the following address:

#### **3. SELECTION OF NOMINEES**

In addition to seeking a nomination from Rep. Van Hollen, you must contact the Admissions Office at each academy to open an admissions file. Following consideration of the applicants, Rep. Van Hollen's Review Board will propose slates of candidates for nominations to each of the service academies. <u>Final</u> decisions on appointments and admission are at the discretion of the service academies.

#### 4. STATISTICS

Of the students who applied to Rep. Van Hollen last year: 54% listed the US Naval Academy as their first choice. 23% listed the US Military Academy as their first choice. 18% listed the US Air Force Academy as their first choice. 5% listed the US Merchant Marine Academy as their first choice.

<u>It is to your advantage to apply to more than one academy</u>. Rep. Van Hollen urges you to research the opportunities afforded by each of the academies to serve the United States as a career officer in the Armed Forces or as a Merchant Mariner.
