

**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT  
FOR H.R. 5303  
OFFERED BY MR. SEAN PATRICK MALONEY OF  
NEW YORK**

At the end of title I, add the following:

1 **SEC. 153. MONITORING FOR UNREGULATED CONTAMI-**  
2 **NANTS.**

3 Section 1445 of the Safe Drinking Water Act (42  
4 U.S.C. 300j-4) is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (a)(2)—

6 (A) by striking subparagraph (A) and in-  
7 serting the following:

8 “(A) ESTABLISHMENT.—

9 “(i) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator  
10 shall promulgate regulations establishing  
11 the criteria for a monitoring program for  
12 unregulated contaminants for all public  
13 water systems, regardless of the number of  
14 people served by a public water system.

15 “(ii) REQUIREMENTS.—In promul-  
16 gating regulations under clause (i), the Ad-  
17 ministrator shall—

1                   “(I) require the monitoring of  
2                   drinking water supplied by public  
3                   water systems; and

4                   “(II) vary the frequency and  
5                   schedule for monitoring requirements  
6                   for public water systems based on—

7                   “(aa) the number of people  
8                   served by a public water system;

9                   “(bb) the source of the  
10                  water supply; and

11                  “(cc) the contaminants likely  
12                  to be found in the water sup-  
13                  ply.”; and

14                  (B) by striking subparagraph (C) and in-  
15                  serting the following:

16                  “(C) GRANTS FOR SMALL AND MEDIUM  
17                  SYSTEM COSTS.—From funds reserved under  
18                  section 1452(o) or appropriated under subpara-  
19                  graph (H), the Administrator shall pay the rea-  
20                  sonable cost of such testing and laboratory  
21                  analysis as are necessary to carry out moni-  
22                  toring to assess the occurrence of unregulated  
23                  contaminants in public water systems that serve  
24                  a population of 10,000 or fewer.”; and

1           (2) in subsection (g), by striking paragraph (7)  
2           and inserting the following:

3           “(7) UNREGULATED CONTAMINANTS.—With re-  
4           spect to contaminants for which a national primary  
5           drinking water regulation has not been established,  
6           the data base shall include—

7                   “(A) monitoring information collected by  
8                   public water systems under subsection (a); and

9                   “(B) other reliable and appropriate moni-  
10                  toring information on the occurrence of the con-  
11                  taminants in public water systems that is avail-  
12                  able to the Administrator.”.
