There are 900 drugs in the adult cancer pipeline, many of which might benefit children. However, very few of the drugs are in pediatric clinical trials. Instead, seriously ill children must hope that they can wait until promising therapies are approved so that they can take them off label, forgoing the benefit of tracking dosages, toxicities and efficacy. Pediatric clinical trials that would confer those benefits open years after the first adult approval and many are not completed.

The Research to Advance Cures and Equity for Children Act (RACE for Children Ac) would promote pediatric studies of novel drugs developed for adults by updating the Pediatric Research Equity Act. As the science of cancer drug development has become one of development of drugs by molecular target, the RACE for Children Act would authorize the U.S. Food and Drug Administration to require PREA studies for pediatric cancers with the same molecular target as the adult cancers under study.

By enacting the RACE for Children Act, we expect to open up vast new opportunities for pediatric cancer drug development. In addition, the new pediatric trials would come with funding for hospitals and pediatric researchers.
