The Committee on Financial Services will hold a hearing entitled "Terrorist Financing and the Islamic State" on Thursday, November 13, 2014, at 10:00 a.m. in room 2167 of the Rayburn House Office Building (i.e., the Transportation and Infrastructure Committee hearing room). This hearing will focus on how organizations like the Islamic State obtain and deploy financial resources to commit acts of terror and further their strategic objectives. The hearing will also examine the effectiveness of current U.S. government efforts to combat terrorist financing generally and to shut off sources of funding for the Islamic State in particular.
