On Tuesday, April 29, 2014, at 2:00 p.m. in room 2128 of the Rayburn House Office Building, the Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations ("Subcommittee") will meet to consider a resolution to authorize the chairman of the Committee to issue subpoenas to compel the appearance and testimony of the below-named individuals:

- 1) M. Stacey Bach, Assistant Director, Office of Equal Employment Opportunity Employment, Consumer Financial Protection Bureau ("CFPB")
- 2) Liza Strong, Director of Employee Relations, CFPB
- 3) Ben Konop, Executive Vice President, National Treasury Employees Union ("NTEU") Chapter 335

Each individual has knowledge pertinent to the Subcommittee's investigation of allegations of retaliation and discrimination at the CFPB. Pursuant to Article I of the Constitution and the rules of the House of Representatives and the Committee on Financial Services, the Subcommittee has the right to compel and receive the testimony of Ms. Bach, Ms. Strong, and Mr. Konop in connection with its investigation. Accordingly, the attached resolution would authorize subpoenas to compel their testimony at an upcoming hearing before the Subcommittee.
