

**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT
OF H.R. 7
OFFERED BY MR. DEFAZIO OF OREGON**

Page 199, strike line 23 and all that follows through
“On October” on line 24 and insert the following:

1 “(c) FUNDING FOR PUBLIC LANDS HIGHWAYS.—

2 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall set
3 aside 40 percent of the funds made available to
4 carry out this section for a fiscal year for public
5 lands highways.

6 “(2) ALLOCATION.—On October 1 of each fiscal
7 year, the Secretary shall allocate the funds author-
8 ized to be appropriated for public lands highways in
9 accordance with section 134 of the Federal-Aid
10 Highway Act of 1987 (23 U.S.C. 202 note; 101
11 Stat. 173).

12 “(3) FOREST SERVICE ADMINISTRATIVE
13 COSTS.—The Secretary shall transfer to the Sec-
14 retary of Agriculture from amounts made available
15 for public lands highways such amounts as may be
16 necessary to cover necessary administrative expenses
17 of the Forest Service in connection with public lands
18 highways.

1 “(d) AGENCY PROGRAM DISTRIBUTIONS.—

2 “(1) IN GENERAL.—After setting aside the
3 amount specified in subsection (c), on October

Page 202, line 1, strike “(d)” and insert “(e)”.

Page 203, strike lines 24 and 25.

Page 204, strike lines 4 through 9 and insert the
following:

4 “(42) FEDERAL LANDS HIGHWAY.—The term
5 ‘Federal lands highway’ means a public road, high-
6 way, bridge, or trail that is located on, is adjacent
7 to, or provides access to Federal lands and—

8 “(A) appears on the national inventory of
9 Federal lands highways maintained under sec-
10 tion 203(e); or

11 “(B) is administered by a State or local
12 government.

Page 204, line 22, strike the closing quotation
marks and the final period.

Page 204, after line 22, insert the following:

13 “(46) PUBLIC LANDS HIGHWAY.—The term
14 ‘public lands highway’ means a Federal lands high-
15 way that is opened to public travel located on, is ad-
16 jacent to, or provides access to lands administered

1 by the United States Forest Service and is adminis-
2 tered by a State or local government.”.
