

**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT
OF H.R. 7
OFFERED BY MR. POSEY OF FLORIDA**

Page 902, insert after line 9 the following: (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

1 SEC. 13 ____ . UNIT COST REPORTING.

2 (a) REPORT REQUIRED.—The agency of each State
3 or territory of the United States, including the District
4 of Columbia, that has responsibility for transportation in
5 that State or territory shall submit to the Committee on
6 Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of Rep-
7 resentatives, the Committee on Environment and Public
8 Works of the Senate, and the Secretary, each Federal fis-
9 cal year for which that State or territory receives funds
10 made available under this Act, including amendments
11 made by this Act, a report under this section.

12 (b) REPORT DESCRIBED.—Each report submitted
13 under subsection (a) shall be prepared in accordance with
14 the following:

15 (1) The report may not exceed one page in
16 length, but may be supplemented by appendices or
17 further explanatory information.

1 (2) The report shall be published on an Inter-
2 net Web site of the agency.

3 (3) The report shall include information on
4 each expenditure by the agency for that year for a
5 transportation activity that the agency began, at-
6 tempted, continued, or completed, including any ac-
7 tivity undertaken by a contractor or subunit of the
8 agency, disaggregated—

9 (A) by program; and

10 (B) as separate line items expressing the
11 unit cost of each activity.

12 (4) The report shall include a demonstration
13 that the sum of the products obtained by multiplying
14 each line item by the number of instances of the ap-
15 plicable activity is equivalent to the total expendi-
16 tures of that agency for that year for transportation
17 activities.

18 (5) The report shall include information, by line
19 item, on any funds that the agency received but did
20 not expend, including funds that the agency has no
21 authority to expend that are passed through to other
22 entities by the agency, and such amounts shall not
23 be expressed in unit cost format.

24 (6) The report shall, to the greatest extent
25 practicable, include activities in a manner that per-

1 mits comparison of activities among each such re-
2 port.

3 (c) PENALTY FOR NONCOMPLIANCE.—The Secretary
4 shall withhold 10 per centum of the amount required to
5 be apportioned to any State or territory under each of sec-
6 tions 104(b)(1) and 104(b)(3) of title 23, United States
7 Code, on the first day of each Federal fiscal year, if that
8 State failed to comply with the requirement under sub-
9 section (a) for the preceding Federal fiscal year, after the
10 first Federal fiscal year beginning after September 30,
11 2012.
