

## AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3221, AS REPORTED OFFERED BY MR. BISHOP OF NEW YORK

At the end of part 1 of subtitle G of title VII of the bill, insert the following (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

2	(a) Policy.—Section 101(a) of the Federal Water
3	Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1251(a)) is amended—
4	(1) by redesignating paragraphs (6) and (7) as
5	paragraphs (7) and (8) respectively; and
6	(2) inserting the following after paragraph (5):
7	"(6) it is the national policy that given the envi-
8	ronmental risk that a floating storage regasification
9	unit poses to an estuary, the construction or use of
10	such a unit in an estuary of national significance be
11	prohibited.".
12	(b) National Estuary Program.—Section 320(g)
13	of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C.
14	1330(g)) is amended by adding at the end the following:
15	"(4) Eligibility.—To be eligible to receive a
16	grant under this subsection, an applicant for a grant
17	shall certify to the Administrator that the applicant
18	will not construct or use a floating storage regasifi-

1	cation unit on an estuary of national significance.
2	Such certification shall remain in effect subject to
3	paragraph (5).
4	"(5) AGENCY OR COURT ORDER.—A grant re-
5	cipient under this subsection may construct or use
5	a floating storage regasification unit on an estuary
7	of national significance only if the recipient is or-
3	dered to do so by a Federal agency or court that has
•	authority to issue such orders.".
