They make up 12 percent of the U.S. homeless population, and in 2014, 3.8 million of the 21.8 million U.S. veterans suffered from mental or physical disabilities as a result of their service.

- 3 View and select your online giving platform (determined by agency and payment preference).

- CFC NEXUS myPay Employees Express 360
- Payroll Deduction*
 - Credit/Debit Card One-Time
 - Credit/Debit Card Recurring
 - eCheck One-Time
 - eCheck Recurring
- *The availability of and the platform for online payroll deduction will vary based on the donor's agency.
