Speaker Boehner Talks "No Budget, No Pay," Balanced Budget With Laura Ingraham

In an interview with Laura Ingraham today, Speaker John Boehner highlighted today's vote on the *No Budget*, *No Pay Act*, said the House will outline a plan to balance the budget within 10 years, and discussed the importance of holding the Obama administration accountable for its response to the terrorist attack in Benghazi. "The House is going to have a plan in our budget to balance the budget over the next 10 years. ... House Republicans are committed to do everything we can to get spending under control."

Boehner on the Terrorist Attack in Libya:

"There are facts out there that make it clear that [the Obama administration] knew this was a terrorist attack and yet they went on for weeks trying to claim that it wasn't. ... We are bound and determined to get to the bottom of who knew what and when, and why the administration continued to deny that this was in fact a terrorist attack. And the fact that they denied these legitimate requests for additional security in Libya."
