Application Requirements and Timetable

Eligibility requirements for all students requesting a Congressional Nomination:

Age: As of July 1 of the year of admission, you must be a least

17 years old, but not yet 22 years old.

Citizenship: Must be a U.S. citizen as of October 15th of the

application year.

Marital Status: Must be unmarried and have no legal obligation to

support children or other dependents.

Domicile: Must be a legal resident of the 6th Congressional District

of Virginia.

Application Timetable:

April 1

Rising 6th District high school seniors may begin submitting application materials to request a Congressional nomination for a Service Academy.

October 15

ALL applications and required materials **MUST** be postmarked by October 15th and addressed to:

In addition to the nomination application, the following materials should be submitted together in a single package to complete your file:

- Official High School transcript to include: grades through the end of your junior year; current GPA; SAT/ACT scores; and class rank (if provided by your high school). The official transcript should be sent to my Lynchburg office in a sealed envelope with a signature across the seal.
- If your most recent SAT/ACT scores are not included in your official school transcript, request that a copy be sent to my office. SAT CODE 5522; ACT CODE 7729
- Statement of extracurricular activities, leadership positions held, and academic and athletic awards received.
- The names, address and phone numbers of three (3) references
- A recent color photo with a solid background.

Applicants are responsible for making sure their files with my office are complete. If you do not submit all of the requested information by the postmarked deadline or do not contact my Lynchburg office at (434) 845-8306 requesting additional time, your application may not be given full consideration.

November & December

I conduct personal interviews with the applicant in November and December and announce my nominations in January.

NOTE: A Congressional nomination is only part of the process leading to admission to a U.S. Service Academy. Applicants are required to notify the Academy where they are seeing admission and to work within the Academy's admissions process.

Service Academy Requirements









The President of the United States, Vice-President, Members of Congress and some ROTC organizations have the authority to nominate persons for admission to a Service Academy.

U.S. Coast Guard Academy

Congressional nominations are not required for admission to the Coast Guard Academy. For more information regarding admission to the Academy, contact the Admissions Office at (860) 444-8500.

NOTE: The U.S. Merchant Marine Academy uses state quotas to determine admission, rather than district quotas. The Commonwealth of Virginia is entitled to five (5) slots in each class of midshipmen at the Academy. Each Congressman may submit up to ten (10) names per year for the Virginia-list. The Virginia nominees then compete against one another for the five slots.
