A BILL

To amend the Residential Lead-Based Paint Hazard Reduction Act of 1992 to define environmental intervention blood lead level.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Lead-Safe Housing5 for Kids Act of 2007".

6 SEC. 2. AMENDING THE RESIDENTIAL LEAD-BASED PAINT 7 HAZARD REDUCTION ACT OF 1992.

8 Section 1017 of the Residential Lead-Based Paint
9 Hazard Reduction Act (42 U.S.C. 4852c) is amended—

(a) by striking "Not later than" and inserting "(a)
 IN GENERAL.—Not later than" with appropriate indenta tion; and

4 (b) by adding at the end the following new subsection:
5 "(b) ENVIRONMENTAL INTERVENTION BLOOD LEAD
6 LEVEL.—For the purpose of this Act, and any regulations
7 issued under this Act, an environmental intervention blood
8 lead level shall be a confirmed concentration of lead in
9 whole blood equal to or greater than 10 ug/dL
10 (micrograms of lead per deciliter) for a single test.".

11 SEC. 3. FEDERAL REGULATIONS.

12 The Secretary of Housing and Urban Development 13 shall amend the regulations of such department to comply 14 with the amendments made by section 2 not later than 15 90 days after the date of the enactment of this Act.
