IMPORTANT GUIDELINES

- > It is your responsibility to apply and register to your academy of interest.
- > You must take the SAT/ACT <u>before October</u> so that your scores will be sent to our office before the deadline. It is *mandatory* to have taken these tests.
- > It would be to your benefit to ask for your letters of recommendations *two or more weeks* prior to sending your packet. It is your responsibility to ensure that the letters have been sent to our office. Please only submit three letters of recommendation.
- > The Academy Selection Committee will not review any incomplete files or information sent after the deadline date.
- **▶** We recommend that you apply through *all of your* Congressional members.
- > You may send in one item at a time or all of the items at once. However, your entire packet must be received in Senator McCain's Phoenix office by the October 20, 2016 deadline.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR A NOMINATION

- > At least 17 but not yet 23 years old by July 1st of the year to be admitted to the Academy. No older than 25 to enter the Merchant Marine Academy.
- > A U. S. citizen and legal Arizona resident when entering the academy.
- > Unmarried, not pregnant, and without legal obligation for the support of a dependent.
- **Minimum** SAT or ACT scores are determined by the perspective Military Academy to which you have applied.

COMPETITIVE APPLICANTS TYPICALLY EXHIBIT THE FOLLOWING:

- **Competitive** SAT or ACT scores are determined by the perspective Military Academy to which applied, 3.7 GPA on a 4.0 scale, and a class rank in the upper 20%
- > Notable participation and performance in extracurricular activities such as:
 - 2. Elected class officer
 - 3. After school and summer employment
 - 4. Athletics
 - 5. Scholastic teams debating, science competitions
 - 6. Community functions
 - 7. Boys/Girls State, Boy/Girl Scouts

MEDICAL STANDARDS

- ➤ Height: Male (62"-78"), Female (60"-72")
- > Preferably 20/20 vision with normal color perception. Waivers are limited.
- ➤ Must pass Medical Examination and Physical Aptitude Exam
 Physical requirements vary among the academies. It is recommended that you contact the academies regarding their specific requirements.

IMPORTANT QUESTIONS YOU MAY ENCOUNTER

HOW CRITICAL ARE MY SAT OR ACT SCORES?

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Aside from your grades, your performance on the SAT or ACT is crucial to the Academy Selection Committee's decision. However, the Academy Selection Committee receives far too many applications to judge each one subjectively. The scores that the Academy Selection Committee assigns to your file are based on your standardized test scores and high school GPA. The other aspects of your application will factor into the selection process if your score is competitive among your peers.

You should register for these tests early in your *Junior* year. This allows you time to retake the tests if you feel that your initial scores do not reflect your true potential. Information regarding test dates may be obtained through your high school counselor.

Applicants are responsible for registering for the SAT or ACT and requesting the scores be sent to your nominating representatives and perspective academies. Senator McCain's SAT code is 4472 and ACT code is 7106.

The committee <u>will not</u> accept any copies of your SAT scores or ACT scores. Scores that are attached to your high school or college transcripts will not be accepted.

If you retake the SAT or ACT tests, please notify our office of any increases in your scores. Please note that the Academy Selection Committee considers your highest scores.

You can have your SAT or ACT scores mailed to Senator McCain's office or you can provide your user name and password for the scores to be accessed by staff via www.collegeboard.com and www.actstudent.org.

WHAT OTHER FACTORS ARE CONSIDERED?

Strong social pressures may influence your decision to attend a service academy. Therefore, one of the most important factors the Academy Selection Committee determines is the nominee's own motivation to attend.

Additional factors the Academy Selection Committee considers are a candidate's athletic activities, military history, leadership ability, involvement in community or church activities, employment history, extracurricular activities, letters of recommendation, and special circumstances. However, please remember these are factored in with the candidate's GPA and standardized test scores.

WHEN DO I APPLY?

You should apply directly to the academies of your choice and to all of the appropriate congressional representatives, between the spring of your Junior year in high school and the fall of your Senior year.

As long as the age requirements are met, high school graduates and college students are encouraged to apply at any time. If you are renewing your application from a prior year, please be sure to update your file and complete a new application form.

Early filing is highly recommended, since it allows the academies and congressional officials more time to familiarize themselves with your personality and academy potential. Also, this allows you more flexibility in scheduling the mandatory medical exam.

Please remember, it is <u>your</u> responsibility to see that <u>all</u> materials are received in our Phoenix office by the deadline. (October 20, 2016 5:00pm – Arizona Time)

TO WHOM DO I APPLY?

Candidates are required to obtain one nomination per service academy from at least one nominating source before they can be offered an appointment. No nominations are required for a Coast Guard Academy appointment. Candidates should apply for a nomination to both of their U.S. Senators and their district congressional representative. Senator McCain represents the entire State of Arizona. If you are unsure of your district congressional representative, you may contact Senator McCain's office or your county's records and elections department for assistance.

A few academy nominations are also available from the Vice President of the United States. Presidential and military nominations are also available to active duty military members, active reserve members, and ROTC cadets. Special nominations are available for children of Medal of Honor recipients, deceased or disabled veterans. Please contact the academies that interest you to obtain information regarding these types of nominations.

HOW ARE THE NOMINEES CHOSEN?

Each U.S. Senator may have five cadets at each one of the three Service Academies (Air Force, Naval, West Point) at any one time. The number of new vacancies available are determined by the number of cadets who graduate or leave the academies each year.

Senator McCain's Academy Selection Committee, comprised of academy graduates and enlisted military veterans, evaluates each candidate. The candidates are evaluated on the basis of their academic and personal achievements. Then, the Academy Selection Committee scores each candidate to determine who will receive an interview. The interviews help determine which candidates are selected for each available vacancy. Senator McCain selects a principal with alternate nominees. In the case of the Merchant Marine Academy, ten nominees are chosen and forwarded for selection.

WILL I GET MY FIRST CHOICE OF ACADEMIES?

In the enclosed application, we ask that you select your service academy preference. Every effort is made to accommodate your first choice. It is important that you request nominations only for the academies you want to attend. If your academy preference changes, please notify our office before the October 15, 2015 deadline.

WHY DO I NEED TO TAKE A PHYSICAL EXAM?

The service academies require a physical examination to determine a candidate's medical qualifications for the rigorous physical portion of the educational programs. Once a precandidate file is opened for your chosen academies, you will be asked to complete a questionnaire. Then, each academy determines the medical examinations scheduling. If you are notified that you are selected to appear for a physical, you will see a physician provided by the Department of Defense Medical Examination Board. There is no cost to the candidate for this examination.

WHEN WILL I KNOW IF I HAVE BEEN NOMINATED OR APPOINTED?

Senator McCain will mail his <u>nomination</u> decision to you by the end of January. The academies will notify you of their appointment decision between mid-January to mid-June.

(Resume format- A summary of your extracurricular activities and length of time involved in each activity, employment experience, honors, awards and other personal achievements)
4) OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL/COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT
(Inform school to include class rank and GPA on your transcripts and send them to the address below. Transcripts <u>have to be official</u> which usually includes a signature and/or school seal. No photocopies of transcripts will be accepted.)
5) SAT AND/OR ACT TEST SCORES
(Sen. McCain's code for SAT is 4472/ ACT is 7106) (Copies of ACT or SAT scores will not be accepted. Scores attached to a high school transcript will not be accepted.)
6) 3 LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION
(Only three letters will be accepted. Do not send more than three letters. Suggested recommendations: school principal, teachers, guidance counselor, military officers, employers, or coaches. Recommendations from relatives or friends are not acceptable!)
