#### REVISED INTERIM SUBALLOCATION OF BUDGET ALLOCATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017

The Committee on Appropriations submits the following report on the revised interim suballocation of budget allocations for fiscal year 2017.

In order to continue developing the 12 fiscal year 2017 appropriations bills, the Committee is providing an interim 302(b) suballocation to two additional subcommittees at this time in order to facilitate their consideration by the House as soon as possible. To date, the Committee has reported five appropriations bills to the House.

The Committee continues to adopt interim allocations given a concurrent resolution for the budget for fiscal year 2017 has yet to be adopted.
