- Please note, if you are applying for the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy, you may seek a nomination from all U.S. Representatives in the State of Georgia. Again, be sure to check their application deadline dates.
- Be sure you have applied for admission to all the academies you are seeking a nomination with before you return your completed application to Congressman Loudermilk's office.
- Once your completed application arrives in Congressman Loudermilk's office, you will receive an email confirmation.
- All applications received will be reviewed by our Military Service Academy Board after the application deadline date.
- You will receive a notification of your application status in late October or early November.
