## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Ready to Work Act5 of 2016".

## 1SEC. 2. AMENDMENT ALLOWING STATES TO MAKE DETER-2MINATIONS REGARDING OCCUPATIONS THAT3REGULARLY CONDUCT DRUG TESTING.

4 (a) AMENDMENT.—Section 303(l)(1)(A)(ii) of the
5 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 503(l)(1)(A)(ii)) is amend6 ed by striking "as determined under regulations issued by
7 the Secretary of Labor" and inserting "as determined by
8 the State".

9 (b) TERMINATION OF AUTHORITY OF EXISTING REG-ULATIONS.—The final rule issued by the Department of 10 Labor on August 1, 2016, entitled "Federal-State Unem-11 ployment Compensation Program; Middle Class Tax Relief 12 and Job Creation Act of 2012 Provision on Establishing 13 Appropriate Occupations for Drug Testing of Unemploy-14 ment Compensation Applicants" (81 Fed. Reg. 50298), 15 shall have no force or effect. 16
