<u>Rep. Gosar (R-AZ)</u> – The amendment increases funding for the Army National Guard by \$2 million, offset by a \$3 million reduction to the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide account. The intent of the amendment is to support National Guard Border Security operations. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Rep. Pascrell (D-NJ)</u> – The amendment decreases, then increases the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide account by \$5 million. The intent of the amendment is to support the Vets4Warriors suicide prevention program. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Rep. Delaney (D-MD)</u> – The amendment increases funding for the Fisher House program by \$5 million, offset by a \$7.5 million reduction to the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide account. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>**Rep. Franks (R-AZ)</u>** – The amendment decreases, then increases the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide account by \$2 million. The intent of the amendment is to support the Electro-Magnetic Pulse Commission. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**</u>

<u>**Rep. Nolan (D-MN)</u>** – The amendment increases funding for the Defense Health Program by \$1 million, offset by a reduction to the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide account. The intent of the amendment is to support lung cancer research. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**</u>

<u>**Rep. McKinley (R-WV)</u>** – The amendment decreases, then increases funding for the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide account by \$5 million. The intent of the amendment is to support the National Guard Youth Challenge program. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**</u>

<u>Rep. Grayson (D-FL)</u> – The amendment increases funding for the Defense Health Program by \$10 million, offset by a reduction in the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide account. The intent of the amendment is to support prostate cancer research. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Rep. Grayson (D-FL)</u> – The amendment increases funding for the Defense Health Program by \$10 million, offset by a reduction in the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide account. The intent of the amendment is to support research on Gulf War Illness. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>**Rep. Speier (D-CA)</u>** – The amendment increases funding for the Defense Health Program by \$5 million, offset by a reduction in the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide account. <u>Rep. Takai (D-HI)</u> – The amendment decreases, then increases the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide account by \$25 million. The intent of the amendment is to support DOD Impact Aid for military=connected school districts. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Rep. Convers (D-MI)</u> – The amendment increases funding for the United Service Organizations (USO) program by \$10 million, offset by a reduction in the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide account. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Rep. Keating (D-MA)</u> – The amendment increases funding for the Defense Health Program by \$1 million, offset by a reduction in the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide account. The intent of the amendment is to support Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy research. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Rep. Jackson Lee (D-TX)</u> – The amendment increases funding for the Defense Health Program by \$1 million, offset by a reduction in the Environmental Restoration, Army account. The intent of the amendment is to support Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) research and treatment. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Rep. Jackson Lee (D-TX)</u> – The amendment increases funding for the Defense Health Program by \$10 million, offset by a reduction to the Procurement, Defense-Wide account. The intent of the amendment is to support breast cancer research. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Rep. Pascrell (D-NJ)</u> – The amendment increases funding for the Defense Health Program by \$25 million, offset by a decrease in the Research Development Test and Evaluation, Defense-Wide account. The intent of the amendment is to support treatment of traumatic brain injuries. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>**Rep. Aguilar (D-CA)</u>** – The amendment decreases, then increases the Defense Health Program by \$1 million. The intent of the amendment is to support suicide prevention programs. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**</u>

<u>**Rep. Huffman (D-CA)</u>** – The amendment strikes section 8053 in the bill relating to the use of American coal at certain military facilities in Germany. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 252-179.**</u>

<u>**Rep. Forbes (R-VA)**</u> – The amendment strikes section 8122 in the bill, which prohibits funding transfers to the National Sea-Based Deterrence Fund. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 321-111.**

<u>Rep. McCollum (D-MN)</u> – The amendment decreases, then increases the Operation and Maintenance, Army account by \$80 million. The intent of the amendment is to support advanced body armor production. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>**Rep. Walberg (R-MI)</u>** – The amendment strikes a provision in the bill that extends funding for certain Afghanistan Infrastructure Fund (AIF) projects. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 233-199.**</u>

<u>Rep. MacArthur (R-NJ)</u> – The amendment prohibits funding from being used to divest or retire, or to prepare to divest or retire, the KC-10 aircraft. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Rep. Walberg (R-MI)</u> – The amendment prohibits funding to comply with the Department of Labor Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs Directive 293, as it applies to TRICARE recipient hospitals. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>**Rep. McSally (R-AZ)</u>** – The amendment prohibits funding to divest or retire, or to prepare to divest or retire, any EC-130H Compass Call aircraft. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**</u>

<u>Rep. Hunter (R-CA)</u> – The amendment prohibits funding to support a price increase of fruits and vegetables made available at commissaries in the Asia-Pacific region. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>**Rep. Yoho (R-FL)</u>** – The amendment prohibits funding within the Iraq Train and Equip fund from being used to procure or transfer man-portable air defense systems. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**</u>

<u>Rep. Yoho (R-FL)</u> – The amendment prohibits funding under Sec. 9014 for "Assistance and Sustainment to the Military and National Security Force of Ukraine" from being used to procure or transfer man-portable air defense systems. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>**Rep. Convers (D-MI)**</u> – The amendment prohibits funding to provide arms, training, or other assistance to the Azov Battalion. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>**Rep.** Cole (R-OK)</u> – The amendment prohibits funding to furlough civilian employees who are paid through the Working Capital Fund. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Rep. Grayson (D-FL)</u> – The amendment prohibits funding to award a contract to a company that has been convicted of, or is currently indicted/civilly charged with a range of crimes, or has delinquent taxes of more than \$3,000 within a three-year period of the offered contract. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>**Rep. Gosar (R-AZ)**</u> – The amendment prohibits funding for Government Travel Charge Card expenses related to gaming or adult entertainment. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>**Rep. McClintock (R-CA)</u>** – The amendment prohibits funding to comply with certain statutory and executive order requirements on renewable energy. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**</u>

<u>**Rep. Jackson Lee (D-TX)</u>** – The amendment prohibits funding from being used in contravention of the authority of the President pursuant to Article II, Sec. 2 of the Constitution. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**</u>

<u>Rep. Guinta (R-NH)</u> – The amendment prohibits funding for a new round of Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC). **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>**Rep. Massie (R-KY)</u>** – The amendment prohibits funding to collect certain information under section 702 of the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act (FISA). **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 255-174.**</u>

<u>**Rep. Nugent (R-FL)</u>** – The amendment prohibits funding to retire certain conventionally armed air-launched cruise missiles. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**</u>

<u>**Rep. Forbes (R-VA)</u>** – The amendment authorizes the transfer of \$3.5 billion of fiscal year 2016 funds to the National Sea-Based Deterrence Fund. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**</u>
