H.R. 2028 – The FY 2016 Energy and Water and Related Agencies Appropriations Act

House Adopted Amendments

<u>Gosar (R-AZ)</u> – The amendment increases Army Corps of Engineers Investigations funding by \$1 million, offset by a reduction in the Department of Energy's (DOE) Departmental Administration account. The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.

<u>Gosar (R-AZ)</u> – The amendment increases Army Corps of Engineers Construction funding by \$3 million, offset by a reduction in DOE's Departmental Administration account. The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.

<u>Patrick Murphy (D-FL)</u> – The amendment increases the Army Corps of Engineers Construction account by \$1 million, offset by a reduction to the Army Corp of Engineers Expenses account. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Duffy (R-WI) – The amendment decreases, then increases, the Army Corps of Engineers Construction account by \$10 million. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Huizenga (R-MI)</u> – The amendment increases funding for the Army Corps of Engineers Operation and Maintenance account by \$36.3 million, offset by a reduction of \$36.7 million in DOE's Departmental Administration account. The intent of the amendment is to meet the annual target for Harbor Maintenance Trust Fund activities established in the Water Resources Reform and Development Act of 2014. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Gosar (R-AZ)</u> – The amendment increases funding for DOE's Office of the Inspector General, offset by a reduction in the Army Corps of Engineers Regulatory Program account. The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.

<u>**Tipton (R-CO)</u>** – The amendment increases the Bureau of Reclamation's Water and Related Resources account by \$2 million, offset by a reduction in DOE's Departmental Administration account. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**</u>

<u>Lamborn (R-CO)</u> – The amendment decreases, then increases, the Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy (EERE) program by \$4 million. The intent of the amendment is to express support for the U.S. – Israel Cooperative Energy Research partnership. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Bonamici (**D-OR**) – The amendment increases funding for EERE by \$9 million, offset by a reduction in DOE's Departmental Administration account. The intent of the amendment is to support the Water Power Office within EERE. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Cohen (D-TN)</u> – The amendment increases funding for EERE by \$2 million, offset by a reduction in DOE's Departmental Administration account. The intent of the amendment is to support the "Super Truck II" program. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Jackson Lee (D-TX)</u> – The amendment decreases, then increases, the DOE Departmental Administration account by \$1 million. The intent of the amendment is to express support for "environmental justice" programs. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Fortenberry (R-NE)</u> – The amendment decreases, then increases, the Defense Nuclear Nonproliferation account by \$13.8 million. The intent of the amendment is to express concern for the Mixed Oxide Fuel (MOX) Fabrication Facility project. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Langevin (D-RI) – The amendment increases funding for the Naval Reactors program by \$2.4 million, offset by a reduction in the National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) Salaries and Expenses account. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>McKinley (R-WV)</u> – The amendment prohibits funds in the bill from transforming the National Energy Technology Laboratory into a government-owned, contractor-operated laboratory, or to consolidate or close the facility. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Babin (**R-TX**) – The amendment prohibits funding in the bill to enter into new contracts or funding agreements with the Islamic Republic of Iran, except agreements that require Iran to cease its purchase, acquisition, or development of nuclear weapons technology. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Engel (D-NY) – The amendment prohibits funding to lease or purchase new light-duty vehicles for any executive fleet, except in accordance with a Presidential Memorandum on Federal Fleet Performance. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Burgess (R-TX)</u> – The amendment prohibits funds in the bill from being used to enforce light bulb standards in the Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007. The amendment was adopted on a vote of 232-189.

Dent (**R-PA**) – The amendment prohibits funds in the bill from being used to finalize, implement, or enforce the DOE's "Standards Ceiling Fans and Ceiling Fan Light Kits" proposed rule. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Napolitano (D-CA)</u> – The amendment prohibits funds from being used in contravention of section 2101 of the Water Resources Reform and Development Act of 2014 and section 210 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1986, related to funding through the Harbor Maintenance Trust Fund. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Stivers (R-OH)</u> – The amendment prohibits funds in the bill from being used to support the Cape Wind Energy Project. The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.

<u>Barton (R-TX)</u> – The amendment increases, then decreases, the Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Civil Works by \$30 million. The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.

<u>Abraham (R-LA)</u> – The amendment prohibits funds in the bill to implement Executive Order 13690 and the associated Federal Flood Risk Management Standard. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Jackson Lee (D-TX)</u> – The amendment prohibits funds in the bill from being used in contravention of the DOE Organization Act. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

Rothfus (R-PA) – The amendment prohibits DOE from using the "Life Cycle Greenhouse Gas Perspective on Exporting Liquefied Natural Gas from the United States" report when the Department makes public interest determinations for liquefied natural gas exports. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 232-172.**

DelBene (D-WA) – The amendment prohibits funds in the bill from being used to purchase a certain anchor and mooring chain unless it is procured from a manufacturer that is part of the national technology and industrial base. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Gosar (R-AZ)</u> – The amendment prohibits funds in the bill from being used to remove any federally owned or operated dam. The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.

<u>**Grayson (D-FL)**</u> – The amendment prohibits funding for contracts to companies convicted of or currently indicted for or civilly charged with various types of federal crimes, including fraud, embezzlement, etc., or that have more than \$3,000 in delinquent taxes within a three-year period surrounding the contract. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

<u>Gosar (D-AZ)</u> – The amendment prohibits funds in the bill for DOE's Climate Model Development and Validation program. The amendment was adopted on a vote of 224-184.

<u>Blackburn (R-TN)</u> – The amendment prohibits funding in the bill from enforcing DOE proposed rules regarding the efficiency of residential gas furnaces. The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.

<u>Luetkemeyer (R-MO)</u> – The amendment prohibits funds in the bill to continue a study pursuant to section 5018(a)1 of the Water Resources Development Act of 2007 – the Missouri River Ecosystem Restoration Plan under the Missouri River Fish and Wildlife Recovery program. The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.

<u>McClintock (R-CA)</u> – The amendment prohibits funds in the bill to purchase water to supplement or enhance the instream flow requirements in California that are mandated under the Endangered Species Act of 1973, The Central Valley Project Improvement Act, or the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 228-183.**

<u>LaMalfa (R-CA)</u> – The amendment prohibits funds in the bill to limit the exemptions from regulation provided in the Clean Water Act for certain agricultural activities. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 239-174.**

<u>LaMalfa (R-CA)</u> – The amendment prohibits funds in the bill to deliver water to the Trinity River above the minimum requirements of the Trinity Record of Decision or to supplement flows in the Klamath River. **The amendment was adopted on a vote of 228-183.**

Duncan (R-SC) – The amendment increases the Corps Investigations account and decreases DOE's Departmental Administration account both by \$2.5 million. **The amendment was adopted on a voice vote.**

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
