TechNet Welcomes McCaul-Warner Security Commission

Washington—TechNet, the bipartisan policy and political network of innovation economy CEOs and senior executives, today welcomed new legislation sponsored by Representative Michael McCaul (R-TX) and Senator Mark Warner (D-VA) that would create a commission to address security issues posed by encryption, law enforcement, and technology.
