Rep. Andrews report language amendment-- Vertical lift platform technologies

Two and a half years ago the Department of Defense Acquisition, Technology & Logistics leadership asked Industry to self-form into the "Vertical Lift Consortium" (VLC). The Department established an Other Transaction Agreement (OTA) with the VLC to more effectively define requirements, streamline development, flight demonstrate innovative Vertical Lift technologies and accelerate transition to the Warfighter at lower risk and cost. The VLC is an open and competitive forum that leverages all sectors of the Vertical Lift Community to encourage teaming of innovative small business and non-traditional contractors with major defense firms and academia.

The Committee supports the Department's engagement with the VLC to obtain input on future vertical lift technology requirements, methods and development strategies for next-generation vertical lift aircraft.

The committee directs the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition, Technology, and Logistics to submit a report to the Congressional Defense Committees not later than March 15, 2013 providing the status of this initiative and, taking into consideration input from the VLC, recommend acquisition approaches for rapid and affordable flight demonstration of innovative Vertical Lift X-planes, including novel acquisition methods such as competitive prize awards that have been successfully applied in other fields.
