The United States Government Accountability Office (GAO) recently released a report about the operation of the Small Business Administration (SBA). Unlike other GAO examinations of the SBA, this investigation did not focus on a particular program; rather, it assessed the overall management and structure of the SBA to determine whether the agency, as currently constituted, was able to meet the mission of providing financial and technical assistance to America's small businesses. GAO found numerous deficiencies in SBA management. The hearing will provide the opportunity for members to examine the GAO findings in greater detail.
