#### **Application Information for Nominations to the United States Service Academies**

**APPLICATION DEADLINE: October 7, 2016** 

Each year, Members of Congress nominate young men and women to become eligible for an appointment to a U.S. Service Academy. The academies are seeking future cadets and midshipmen who possess "whole person" qualifications: good moral character, a commendable academic record, evidence of strong leadership potential, physical aptitude, medical fitness, motivation to achieve academically, and eventually, the desire to serve as an officer in the Armed Forces.

Later this year, I will make ten nominations for each House of Representative vacancy at:

- The United States Air Force Academy, Colorado Springs, Colorado
- The United States Military academy, West Point, New York
- The United States Naval Academy, Annapolis, Maryland
- The United States Merchant Marine Academy, Kings Point, New York

Nominations will be based entirely on the recommendations of my Merit Selection Committee which consists of community representatives from Colorado. The nominating process begins with the accompanying application packet. All required forms and documents **must** be on file in my office by the deadline: October 7, 2016. If your file is complete at that time and you are eligible, you will be scheduled for a personal interview with my Citizen Advisory Board. I will announce my nominations before the end of the year.

After my nominations have been submitted to the academies, the Admissions Office of each academy will offer the actual appointments to successful nominees. The announcement of appointments can begin as early as January and will continue for several months until the ranks of the next entering classes are full.

Because the nomination process is **extremely competitive**, be sure to apply to all nominating sources available to you. Also, you should indicate your alternative choices in case you do not receive a nomination to your first academy choice. Give yourself the benefit of every opportunity! #### U.S. SERVICE ACADEMY NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS

To qualify for an appointment to any service academy, an applicant must meet the following statutory criteria:

- American citizenship
- At least 17 years of age and not yet 23 years old on July 1st of the year the applicant would enter an academy (25 years old for the USMMA)
- Unmarried
- Not pregnant and without legal obligation to support children or other dependents

In addition to statutory requirements, each academy has established academic, physical, and leadership requirements for admission. Candidates for appointment to each academy must:

- Demonstrate comprehensive academic preparation
- Demonstrate leadership, athletic ability, and participation in extracurricular activities
- Take the SAT or the ACT Assessment
- Be in good physical and mental health
- Pass a comprehensive medical examination
- Pass a physical aptitude examination

Specific requirements in each of the academic, physical, and leadership categories vary by academy and are revised regularly. In preparation for making appointments, a Congressional office might review each academy's most recent class profile for specific information on scores and class rankings and activities of recently admitted students. Some of this information is available on the website for each academy.

To be eligible for an appointment to a U.S. Service Academy, you MUST follow two procedures at the same time; apply to the service academy and receive a Congressional Nomination.

#### **Service Academy Application**

In addition to requesting a nomination from a Member of Congress or another nominating official, an individual seeking appointment to a service academy must separately apply to each service academy in which he or she seeks to be appointed. Each academy requires the submission of a preliminary application to initiate the admission process. Preliminary application materials are available from each academy website listed below. Acceptance of a service academy nomination requires at least a nine-year service obligation, including four years at an academy and five years of active duty service.

#### **Congressional Nomination**

#### You must submit the following to my office by Friday, October 7, 2016

- 1. An official application that includes concise (one page only) answers to the essay questions (Résumés *cannot* be substituted for an official application).
- 2. The School Recommendation Form (found in this packet).
- 3. The School Recommendation Form must include your *official high school transcript* bearing an <u>official</u> seal or stamp or the signature and title of a school official.
- 4. Two letters of recommendation from a teacher, principal, guidance counselor, employer, coach, extracurricular faculty advisor, community leaders, church leaders, scout/CAP/JROTC leaders, or other adults you know well. These two letters are in addition to the counselor/principal's information on the School Recommendation Form in the application packet.
- Official ACT or SAT scores. To apply for a nomination, one of the two test scores
  must be submitted. A *certified copy of the high school record* of these scores will be
  accepted.
- 6. A wallet sized picture of yourself along with your application.

Your completed original application with all components MUST be received by my District Office on Friday, October 7, 2016 at 5:00PM. Faxed or scanned copies will not be accepted.



Your answers should reflect **your own beliefs and convictions,** not what you think someone else might want to hear. Feel free to do research. Although the **content** of your answers is of greatest importance; grammar, spelling, punctuation and writing style will also be considered.

Please limit each answer to one (1) page, double-spaced, and answer all four questions. When completed, attach your four essay pages to this cover page with a paper clip (*not a staple*) and return it with your application.

Please print the numbered questions, with your answers on four separate pages.

- 1. Are you planning on a military career? If yes, in what field or area would you want to specialize as an officer? Please explain.
- 2. What benefits do you expect to receive from attendance at a service academy rather than a civilian college or university?
- 3. Under what circumstances, if any, do you think it would be appropriate to question or disobey the orders of a superior officer?
- 4. If, as the commanding officer of a military unit in combat, you have taken prisoners of war, what humanitarian provisions should you know about the Geneva Convention and its applications to prisoners of war?
