

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4937
OFFERED BY MR. NOLAN OF MINNESOTA

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 **SEC. 22. IDENTIFICATION OF SOURCES OF STEEL USED TO**
2 **CONSTRUCT, REPLACE, OR MAINTAIN PIPE-**
3 **LINE FACILITIES.**

4 (a) PIPELINE INVENTORY STANDARDS.—Section
5 60102(e) of title 49, United States Code, is amended—

6 (1) in paragraph (1) by striking “and” at the
7 end;

8 (2) in paragraph (2) by striking the period at
9 the end and inserting “; and”; and

10 (3) by adding at the end the following:

11 “(3) for a gas or hazardous liquid pipeline facil-
12 ity constructed or replaced after the date of enact-
13 ment of this paragraph, shall include—

14 “(A) an identification of the total amount
15 of steel by volume used to construct, replace, or
16 maintain the pipeline facility;

17 “(B) an identification of the total amount
18 of steel by volume identified under subpara-
19 graph (A) that was produced outside of the
20 United States, together with a separate esti-

1 mate of that volume for each country of origin
2 of the steel; and

3 “(C) an identification of the total amount
4 of steel by volume identified under subpara-
5 graph (A) that originated from domestic
6 sources, together with—

7 “(i) an identification of whether that
8 steel was produced, processed, or fab-
9 ricated in the United States; and

10 “(ii) for steel identified under clause
11 (i) that was not produced in the United
12 States, an identification of the origin of
13 the semi-finished steel processed or fab-
14 ricated in the United States.”.

15 (b) REPORTS TO CONGRESS.—Section 60102 of title
16 49, United States Code, is amended by adding at the end
17 the following:

18 “(q) ANNUAL REPORT TO CONGRESS.—

19 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after
20 the date of enactment of this subsection, and annu-
21 ally thereafter, the Secretary shall prepare a report
22 that contains, with respect to a gas or hazardous liq-
23 uid pipeline facility constructed or replaced after the
24 date of enactment of this subsection, the information
25 described in subsection (e)(3).

1 “(2) ACCESS TO PIPE INVENTORY STAND-
2 ARDS.—For purposes of preparing the report, the
3 Secretary may require the operator of a pipeline fa-
4 cility to submit to the Secretary on an annual basis
5 the information required to be maintained by the op-
6 erator under subsection (e)(3).

7 “(3) PUBLIC AVAILABILITY.—The Secretary
8 shall publish the report in the Federal Register and
9 make the report available on the public Internet
10 Web site of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials
11 Safety Administration.”.
