I see the priority is to discuss is VV13 since it is the first one for Monday. this morning tells me Jorge and he chatted briefly about the security concern for VV13 and discussed substituting VV22 but that one is also on Jorge's list because so difficult to reach in the middle of the expanse of wetland.
