Congressional District 4: DID YOU KNOW?

In November 1934, when construction crews from California illegally began construction of Parker Dam (which creates Lake Havasu) on the Arizona side of the Colorado River, the governor of Arizona, Benjamin Moeur, declared martial law and called up the National Guard. He gave the troops the mission of protecting the "sacred soil of old Arizona," so they set up machine guns to defend the Arizona side of the Colorado. The almost-war ended when the U.S. Supreme Court sided with Arizona.
