I recently introduced the Fiscal Responsibility in Federal Contracting Act (<u>H.R.4403</u>). This legislation suspends the onerous and outdated wage requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act, saving the American taxpayer billions of dollars and allowing contractors to put more people to work.
