

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5
OFFERED BY MS. VELÁZQUEZ OF NEW YORK

Page 66, insert after line 18 the following:

1 (e) EFFECTIVE DATE; STUDY AND CERTIFICATION
2 REQUIRED REGARDING COST, RESOURCE DUPLICATION,
3 AND AGENCY WASTE.—The amendments made by this
4 section shall take effect only beginning on the date that
5 the Chief Counsel for Advocacy of the Small Business Ad-
6 ministration—

7 (1) submits a report to the Committee on Small
8 Business of the House of Representatives and the
9 Committee on Small Business and Entrepreneurship
10 of the Senate on the feasibility, personnel resources
11 required, and overall cost to the Chief Counsel of
12 carrying out the responsibilities of the Chief Counsel
13 under the amendments made in section 310, includ-
14 ing an analysis of whether carrying out such respon-
15 sibilities will result in a duplication of functions in
16 the Small Business Administration, including those
17 of the Office of Size Standards; and

18 (2) certifies to the Committee on Small Busi-
19 ness of the House of Representatives and the Com-
20 mittee on Small Business and Entrepreneurship of

1 the Senate that the Chief Counsel may carry out the
2 responsibilities of the Chief Counsel under the
3 amendments made in section 310 without creating
4 any limitation on the ability of the Chief Counsel to
5 carry out other statutory duties.
