Dear Friend:

After nearly a year in the majority, the House Republican Leadership has yet to address the number one priority of the American people – job creation. Instead of working to put the American people back to work, their time as leaders in Congress has been marked by missed opportunities. In order to protect tax breaks for the wealthy and those that ship jobs overseas, they have failed to bring forth a jobs agenda and have focused on proposals that undermine programs working to preserve the health, education and well-being of all Americans. This past spring, House Democrats stood united against the Republican effort to end Medicare as we know it. Their plan immediately raises costs for seniors, cuts funding for Medicare and forces many vulnerable seniors and people with disabilities to buy private insurance with a voucher that decreases in value each year.
