- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Jeremy Sanchez Social
- 5 Security Disability Insurance Fairness Act".

1	SEC. 2. NON-APPLICATION OF WAITING PERIOD FOR DIS-
2	ABILITY INSURANCE BENEFITS IN CASES OF
3	TERMINALLY ILL BENEFICIARIES.
4	Section 223(a) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
5	423(a)) is amended by adding at the end the following:
6	"(3)(A) In the case of any application for dis-
7	ability insurance benefits filed by an individual who
8	is determined to be under a disability, paragraph (1)
9	shall be applied without regard to the waiting period
10	referred to in such paragraph if—
11	"(i) the individual is terminally ill, or
12	"(ii) the Commissioner of Social Security
13	determines that the application of the waiting
14	period would work an undue hardship on such
15	individual (as determined on the basis of cri-
16	teria established by the Commissioner).
17	"(B) For the purposes of this paragraph, an in-
18	dividual is considered to be terminally ill if the indi-
19	vidual has a medical prognosis that the individual's
20	life expectancy is 12 months or less.".
21	SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.
22	The amendment made by section 2 shall apply with
23	respect to applications for monthly insurance benefits filed
24	on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
