SERVICE ACADEMY NOMINATION CHECKLIST

Representative Amash's Requirements:

- 1. Complete the Service Academy Application Form available at Amash.house.gov. (Look for the anchor that states Academy Nominations).
- 2. Provide a transcript of your high school grades (and any college grades, if applicable) through the most recent grading period.
- 3. Provide a statement from your guidance counselor as to your projected rank in your class and your cumulative grade point average.
- 4. Provide three letters of recommendation from representative members of your community who are in a position to comment on your leadership ability, character, and suitability for an academy nomination and military career. It is suggested that the letters come from people who can give a view of all aspects of your life, for example, teacher, clergyman, coach, or family friend, not all one or the other.
- 5. Provide copies of your ACT and/or SAT scores. These can be a part of the official transcript provided by your high school, or the most recent scores available to you.
- 6. A picture of yourself.
- 7. Submit information to Representative Amash no later than November 1, 2017 for Class of 2022.

Spring of Junior Year of High School: Through the website, complete an application

for nomination. Submit the application and other required documents as noted on Representative Amash's Service Academy

Nomination Checklist.

Summer through October of Applications for nominations accepted at

Senior Year of High School: Congressional Office.

November 1: Application DEADLINE.

Mid-November: Congressional staff notifies each candidate of

interview time and location.

Mid-December: Interviews with Representative

Amash's Academy Advisory Board.

End of December: Representative Amash's office notifies

candidates on their nomination status.

End of December: Nomination forms are submitted to each

academy.
