The Federation of American Hospitals (FAH), representing more than 1,100 investor-owned or managed hospitals and health systems throughout the United States, is pleased to express our support for H.R. 3742, the Antibiotic Development to Advance Patient Treatment (ADAPT) Act.

Antimicrobial resistance is an issue of great importance to hospitals which serve as the front line in the fight against infectious disease. Accelerating development of new treatments is critical to our ability to treat patients with serious infections who lack sufficient therapeutic options.

The FAH supports your work to create incentives to encourage companies to further engage in the development and production of new anti-bacterial and anti-fungal pharmaceutical products. We also support provisions in the bill that strengthen monitoring by the CDC of resistance and antibiotic use and make these data publically available.
